

## Install Officers Of New Jabez Capps Barracks

In the same court room in the old Logan county court house building, in the Mount Pulaski public square, that Abraham Lincoln tried cases before Judge David Davis of Bloomington, in the years 1848-1854, members and friends of the newly organized Jabez Capps Barracks No. 2260 of the Veterans of World War I of Mount Pulaski, assembled Sunday afternoon, Aug. 28, 1960, to witness the installation of officers.

Past Commander Oscar Martin of the Decatur Barracks of Veterans of World War I, obligated and installed the officers, and was to have presented the charter, but it had not arrived from headquarters. The charter was presented at the next meeting.

Shelley (formerly Florence Capps), of Wichita, Kans., and Mrs. Eugene Manes (formerly Harriet Capps), of Mount Pulaski. The grandson, Paul E. Beidler, was represented by his wife, who expressed the gratefulness of the family for the honor bestowed upon the memory of Jabez Capps by naming the Barracks for him.

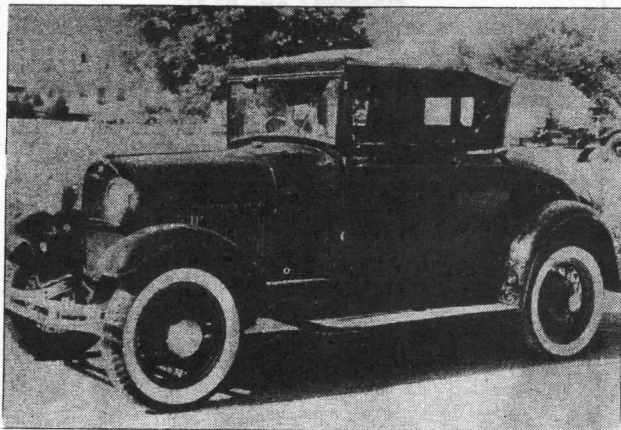
